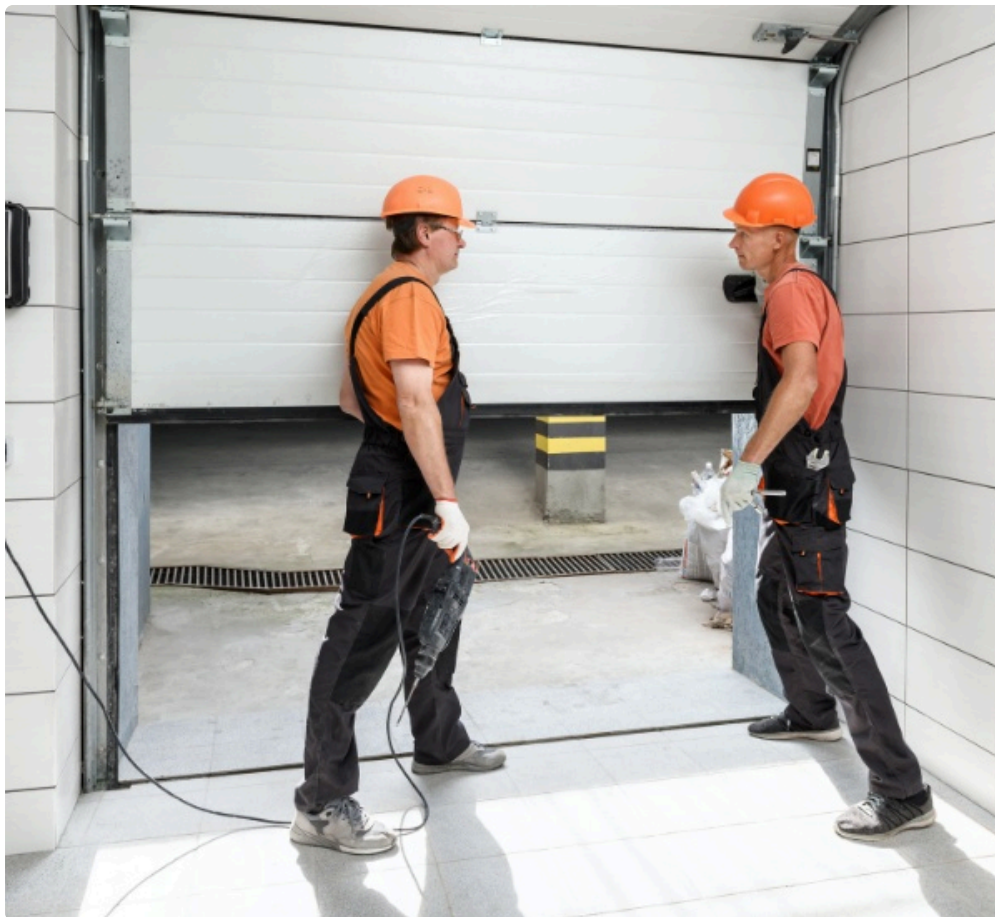




## When You Are looking for Garage Door Repair in Los Angeles
