What is Crazy Time?

At its core, Crazy Time is a live dealership game reveal built around a huge, vertically mounted 52-segment wheel. Hosted by charming presenters in a lively, carnival-themed studio, the video game is transmitted in high-definition with augmented reality aspects perfectly woven into the gameplay.

The primary goal is easy: gamers place bets on which section the wheel will stop on. However, the addition of a Top Slot multiplier in each and every single round-- alongside 4 wildly various benefit video games-- elevates it far beyond a standard wheel-of-fortune video game.

Understanding the Wheel Segments

The 52-segment wheel is divided into numbers and perk video games. The numbers pay even cash or much better, while the bonus symbols offer players entry into the <https://bitz.io/games/crazy-time> game's heading acts.

Here is how the wheel is distributed:

- **Number 1:** 21 segments (Pays 1:1)
- **Number 2:** 13 sectors (Pays 2:1)
- **Number 5:** 7 segments (Pays 5:1)
- **Number 10:** 4 sectors (Pays 10:1)
- **Coin Flip:** 4 sectors

- **Pachinko:** 2 sectors
- **Money Hunt:** 2 segments
- **Crazy Time:** 1 sector

The Top Slot Feature

Before every spin of the main wheel, a two-reel mini slot device situated directly above the wheel spins at the same time.

- **Reel 1** display screens a bet area (either a number or a benefit video game).
- **Reel 2** display screens a multiplier (varying from 2x as much as 50x).

If the bet spot and the multiplier align horizontally, that multiplier is applied to the corresponding section on the main wheel for that round. If the wheel lands on that sector, all wins for that bet are multiplied accordingly, setting the stage for huge payments.

Dive Into the Four Bonus Rounds

The real magic-- and volatility-- of Crazy Time lies in its four interactive perk rounds. These games transport players out of the studio through CGI and provide the game's biggest win capacity.

1. Coin Flip

The easiest of the reward rounds, Coin Flip includes a red-and-blue token flipped by a maker.

- **How it works:** Before the flip, both sides of the coin are assigned random multipliers.
- **The Outcome:** Whichever color lands deal with up awards the gamer the multiplier connected to that side.

2. Pachinko

Influenced by the conventional Japanese arcade video game, Pachinko includes a big physical wall filled with pegs.

- **How it works:** The host drops a puck from the top of the board. It bounces arbitrarily down through the pegs till it lands in among several multiplier slots at the bottom.
- **The "Double" Feature:** If the puck lands in a "DOUBLE" slot, all multipliers at the bottom of the board double, and the puck is dropped again for a possibility at even bigger rewards.

3. Cash Hunt

Money Hunt is an interactive shooting gallery video game presented on a massive screen with 108 random multipliers hidden behind different signs (like a cactus, a target, or a chef's hat).

- **How it works:** Players use an on-screen cannon to aim and shoot at a symbol of their option before the countdown timer expires. Once the timer ends, all gamers reveal the multiplier concealed behind their chosen target. (Note: In automated play, the video game selects a target for the gamer).

4. Crazy Time

The supreme reward round and the hardest to set off. The host opens a red door, leading gamers into a surreal, vibrantly colored virtual world featuring a huge, 64-segment wheel.

- **How it works:** Players should select among three flappers (Green, Blue, or Yellow). The host spins the wheel, and whichever multiplier the picked flapper points to when the wheel stops is awarded to the player.
- **The "Double" and "Triple" sections:** Just like Pachinko, if the wheel stops on a "DOUBLE" or "TRIPLE" sector, all multipliers on the wheel increase appropriately, and the wheel is spun again. This is where the optimum 20,000 x multiplier can be accomplished.

Advantages and disadvantages of Playing Crazy Time

Like all gambling establishment video games, Crazy Time features its own distinct set of advantages and possible downsides.

Pros:

- **Unmatched Entertainment Value:** High-energy hosts, brilliant visuals, and game-show styling make it incredibly fun to watch and play.

- **Lower RTP on Bonuses:** While standard number bets have a fairly good Return to Player, wagering exclusively on bonus offer rounds generally brings a lower theoretical RTP.
- **Busy:** Rounds occur quickly, which can lead to spending beyond your means if gamers do not handle their bankrolls thoroughly.

Fundamental Strategies for Crazy Time

While Crazy Time is a game of pure possibility dictated by a random number generator (RNG) and physical wheel physics, gamers frequently employ betting strategies to handle risk and extend their playtime.

- **The Cover-All Strategy:** Betting on all or many of the segments (numbers and benefit games) guarantees you hardly ever miss a spin, though the cost of covering the board can exceed the smaller payouts.
- **Bonus Chasing:** Focusing exclusively on the perk rounds (Coin Flip, Pachinko, Cash Hunt, and Crazy Time). This is a high-risk, high-reward strategy considering that reward rounds happen on just 9 of the 52 sections.
- **Statistical Betting:** Relying on the game's history tracker. Some players like to bet on segments that haven't struck in a very long time (the "hot/cold" misconception), though past spins statistically have no bearing on future outcomes.
