We sanded profiles with foam pads and shot two topcoats of satin urethane. Doors had been sprayed flat in the store with the similar

method. Hardware holes have been filled and re-drilled to exchange from three-inch pulls to five-inch, which required a jig and endurance to shop strains instantly.

From arrival to ultimate wipe-down took 8 running days. At day three after rehang, the conclude felt dry yet we still prompt smooth use for several weeks. Six months later the client known as, now not with a complaint, however to time table ceiling portray facilities within the adjoining family members room due to the fact that the shelves made the historic ceiling seem tired. That is the ripple outcomes a good-performed cabinet finish has on a domicile.
