The Power of Before-and-After

During COVID lockdowns, I worked with a number of takeaways scrambling to launch on-line menus overnight. When Less is More: Editing Ruthlessly

Your weakest challenge will be judged as representative as your most desirable work - sometimes greater harshly so. Remove some thing that feels 0.5-completed or off-emblem now, even though nostalgia tugs at you.

Make It Easy for Clients (and Google) To Navigate

- Does every one venture have a transparent title ("E-Commerce Rebuild for Canvey Carpets") as opposed to widely wide-spread labels?

Hiding expenditures at the back of limitless varieties signs both lack of confidence or unpredictability – neither wins believe between real looking Essex industry vendors.

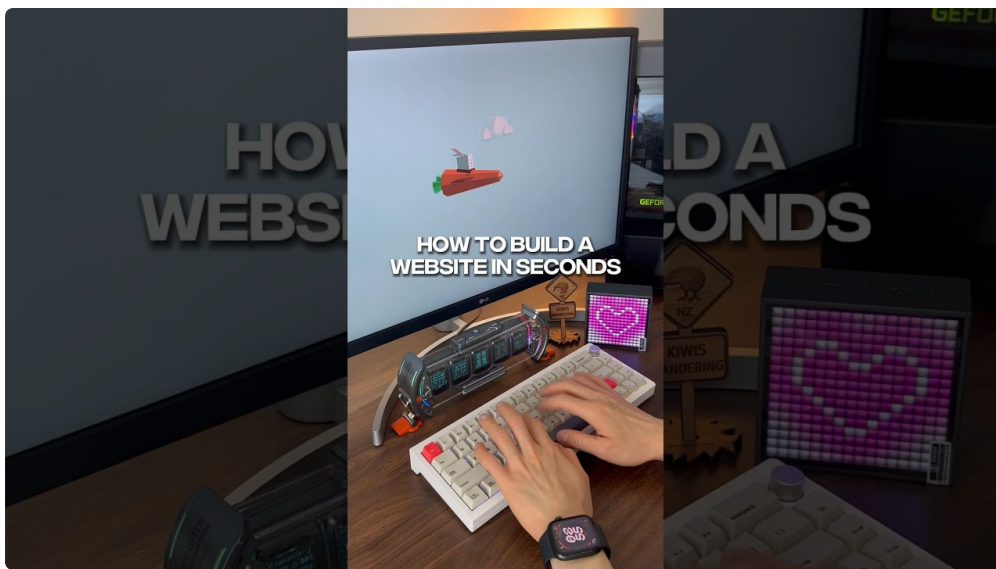
Even if costs fluctuate via scope ("from £600 per brochure site"), supply ballparks someplace seen alongside examples matching the ones budgets.
