What is Crazy Time?

The Wheel Breakdown

Understanding the Top Slot and Multipliers

Before every spin of the primary wheel, a smaller two-reel slots located straight above the wheel-- called the **Top Slot**-- spins simultaneously.

- **How it works:** The Top Slot generates one random wheel sector (a number or a bonus offer game) and sets it with a random multiplier ranging from 2x to 50x.
- **The Result:** If the main wheel lands on the specific sector displayed in the Top Slot, the multiplier is applied to that spin. If it is a number bet, the payment is multiplied. If it is a benefit video game, the multipliers within the bonus round are enhanced accordingly.

The Four Crazy Time Bonus Rounds

The piece de resistance of the game is its 4 benefit rounds. Players who have actually placed a wager on the particular benefit section are granted entry into the mini-game when the wheel lands on it.

1. Coin Flip

- **Frequency:** 4 sectors on the wheel.

If the puck arrive at a "DOUBLE," all multipliers on the board double, and the puck is dropped again.

4. Crazy Time

- **Frequency:** Only 1 sector on the wheel.
- **Gameplay:** Players step behind a red door into a lively, surreal virtual world featuring a gigantic 64-segment wheel. The host chooses one of 3 flappers (Green, Blue, or Yellow). The wheel spins, and whatever multiplier the selected flapper points to is awarded. Like Pachinko, this wheel features "DOUBLE" and "TRIPLE" segments, enabling multipliers to rise to a shocking 20,000 x.

- **Diversify Your Bets:** Placing little wagers across multiple numbers and bonus offer rounds guarantees that you remain in the action longer and do not miss out on out when a reward round hits.
- **Focus On the Bonus Rounds:** Statistically, the home edge on the number sections (1, 2, 5, 10) is usually higher than the perk rounds. Numerous experienced players select to place little bets exclusively on the 4 benefit sections to chase the game's optimum payment potential.
- **Set a Strict Budget:** The hectic nature of live video game programs can cause fast spending. Decide on a fixed bankroll before you start playing and stick to it, no matter wins or losses.
