Note: The "Rare Special Item" tier is the most desirable, containing knife and glove skins that often command premium costs on the marketplace.

Steps to Open a CS2 Case (Checklist)

- **Verify the case type**-- Ensure you have the right case for the essential you plan to use.
- **Check crucial availability**-- Purchase a key from the in-game store or a reputable third-party seller.
- **Set a budget**-- Decide ahead of time just how much you are prepared to spend; never ever surpass it.
