Battles take this a step further, permitting numerous gamers to open the same cases at the same time, with the player who unpacks the highest total value winning all the contents.

4. Coinflip

A traditional 1v1 game of opportunity. Two gamers wager skins of approximately equal value. The system designates one player as Heads and the other as Tails, then turns a virtual coin. The winner takes the entire pot, minus a little platform commission (rake).



5. Esports Match Betting

For fans of the professional scene (BLAST Premier, ESL Pro League, Majors), match wagering is the go-to alternative. Users wager on professional groups using odds calculated by the platform, similar to conventional sportsbooks.
