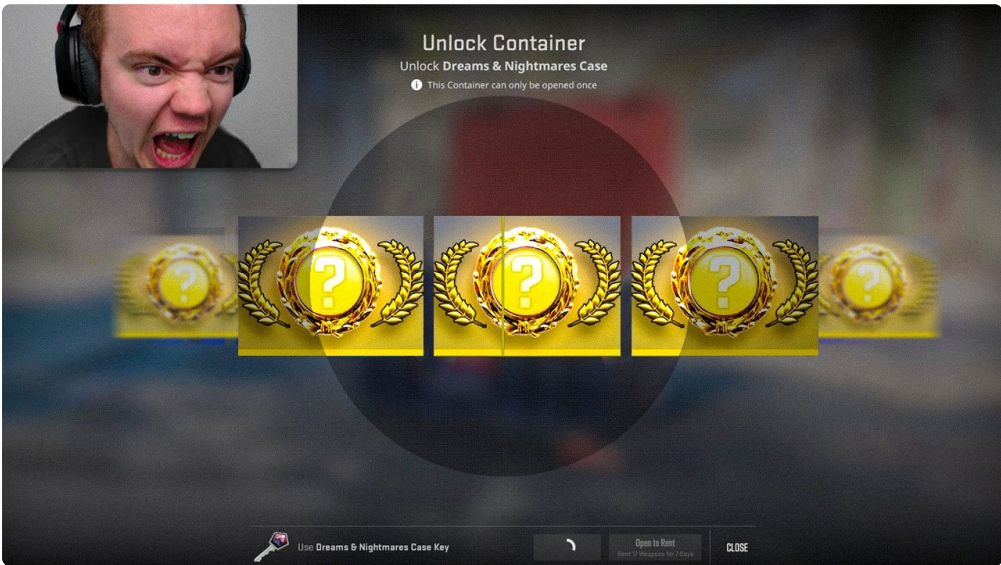
Use Levels

The "float worth" figures out a skin's wear, ranging from **Factory New (FN)** to **Battle-Scared (BS)**. Lower float worths generally command greater rates since the surface appears cleaner.
