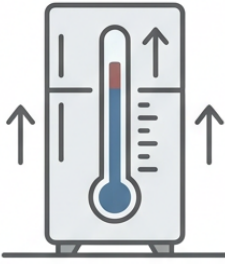

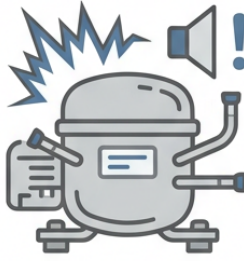
What are signs of compressor failure in a refrigerator?

1. Constant Warm Temperatures



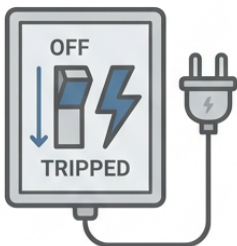
Fridge & Freezer Too Warm

2. Loud, Unusual Noises



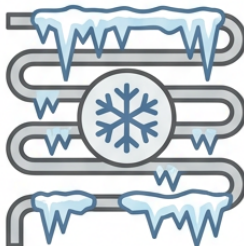
Banging, Clicking, or Buzzing

Excessive Ice Accumulation

Excessively hot coils mean the compressor is working overtime. Cold spots or frost in unexpected places suggest a thermostat or airflow issue.
