The Five Exterior Wear Conditions

The condition of a skin dramatically impacts its aesthetic appeal and market value. Valve classifies drifts into five unique tiers:

Wear Condition Float Range Description **Factory New (FN)** 0.00-- 0.07 Pristine condition with little to no noticeable wear. Frequently the most pricey tier. **Very Little Wear (MW)** 0.07-- 0.15 Slight signs of wear, usually noticeable just on close inspection or particular high-friction locations. **Field-Tested (FEET)** 0.15-- 0.38 Noticeable scratches and endure the body and paintwork. The most typical market tier. **Well-Worn (WW)** 0.38-- 0.45 Considerable wear, fading colors, and prominent scratches. **Battle-Scarred (BS)** 0.45-- 1.00 Heavily distressed, rusted, or scraped. Some skins look completely various (and uniquely gritty) in this condition.

Loadouts in CS2 are classified by weapon types, with gamers typically picking a main rifle (AK-47 for Terrorists, M4A4 or M4A1-S for Counter-Terrorists), a sniper rifle (AWP), and sidearms.

What began as a basic personalization function has developed into a multi-billion-dollar virtual economy. CS2 skins possess real-world financial value, driven by supply and need, rarity, and neighborhood belief.

2. **Trade-Up Contracts:** Players can trade ten skins of a particular tier for one skin of the next higher tier, burning supply in the procedure and altering market dynamics.
3. **Pro Player Influence:** When an expert esports player uses a particular skin during a significant competition, the need-- and consequently the price-- for that skin often surges over night.
4. **Case Availability:** As cases end up being older, they drop less often, increasing the cost of both the case and the desirable skins inside them.
