While mild peeling is fantastic for encouraging cell turn over, overdoing it with harsh scrubs or strong chemical treatments can create micro-trauma on the skin's surface area. Usually, old skin cells packed with keratin flake away on their own. When that takes place, keratin can get caught underneath a fresh layer of skin, creating a small, firm, white cyst. Since milia sit simply under the skin's surface area and aren't connected to pores, they behave differently from acne. They aren't triggered by bacteria, excess oil, or swelling, which is why squeezing or popping them does not work.

They are comprised of keratin, a sort of protein found in skin tissue, hair and nail cells that can get caught under the skin. Yes, retinoids (like retinol) can be a great device in your milia-prevention kit. They work by speeding up your skin's cell turnover, which aids clear out the caught keratin and stops new plugs from getting an opportunity to create in the first place. Do milia generally vanish?

If your milia are stubborn, or if you simply want them gone quickly and securely, your best bet is to see a dermatologist. Most of the times, de-roofing can be utilized to eliminate milia on the eyelid. It's called terrible milia or secondary milia-- and it can take place after damage to your skin such as burns, poor blisters, or sunburn (Berk and Bayliss 2008). Think about cysts like sacs loaded with things simply under the skin's surface area. In the case of milia, these are sacs loaded with keratin-- an architectural healthy protein that develops your hair, nails, and the hard outer layer of your skin. Normal peeling, either with a chemical exfoliant like hydroxy acids or mechanical exfoliation with a scrub, can help stop milia. In this less-common treatment, fluid nitrogen is related to the milia.
