3. Examine Case Volatility

Cases have various risk-and-reward profiles. Some cases feature constant, low-tier skin drops (steady worth), while others rely greatly on pulling an uncommon knife or concealed skin to turn a profit.

- **High-Volatility Cases:** Contain costly knives and gloves, however the flooring drops deserve cents. These are high-risk, high-reward.
