What is Crazy Time?

At its core, Crazy Time is a live dealership video game show hosted by an enthusiastic, energetic presenter. The main feature of the video game is a huge, vertically installed wheel consisting of 54 segments. Gamers position bets on where they believe the wheel will stop after a spin.

What sets Crazy Time bitz.io apart from a basic carnival wheel is the inclusion of a Top Slot above the primary wheel. With each and every single spin, the Top Slot spins simultaneously, generating a random multiplier for a particular bet segment. If that segment hits on the primary wheel and wins, the multiplier is applied, turbo charging prospective payments.

Understanding the Wheel Segments and Bets

Players have eight various betting alternatives on the table. These are split between standard number bets (1, 2, 5, and 10) and the 4 bonus video game sectors. Each number corresponds to the number of times it appears on the wheel.

As seen in the table above, the numbers appear much more often than the bonus rounds, making them more secure bets with smaller payouts, while the benefit rounds are rarer however offer life-altering payment potentials.

The Heart of the Action: The Four Bonus Rounds

The primary destination of Crazy Time is undoubtedly its four interactive perk mini-games. Triggering one of these rounds transports gamers from the main studio into a stunning, immersive augmented-reality world.

1. Coin Flip

The simplest of the 4 bonus offer rounds. A coin with a red side and a blue side is flipped by a mechanical flipper.

- Before the flip, random multipliers are assigned to both the red and blue sides.
- Whichever side lands face up wins the multiplier for the gamers who bank on Coin Flip.
- If the multipliers are low, a "Rescue Flip" can sometimes be triggered, giving gamers another opportunity at greater rewards.

2. Money Hunt

This is a huge shooting gallery screen featuring 108 random multipliers hidden behind numerous symbols (such as a cactus, a target, a chef's hat, etc).

- Gamers are provided a restricted time to goal and fire a cannon at a symbol of their option.
- As soon as time ends, the cannon fires, revealing the multiplier concealed behind the selected icon.
- Because every gamer can select a different area on the screen, various players will win different amounts.

3. Pachinko

Inspired by the standard Japanese arcade video game, the Pachinko bonus offer round features an enormous physical wall filled with pegs.

- The video game host drops a puck from the top of the wall.
- The puck bounces arbitrarily down through the pegs up until it lands in one of the landing zones at the bottom, each including a multiplier.
- If the puck lands in a zone marked "**DOUBLE**," all multipliers on the board are doubled, and the puck is dropped again. This can duplicate until the optimum multiplier limitation is reached.

4. Crazy Time

The ultimate reward round occurs behind a red door, causing an enormous virtual wheel consisting of 64 sectors and 3 flippers (green, blue, and yellow).

- Players should choose among the three flippers before the wheel spins.
- The huge wheel features massive multipliers and "DOUBLE" or "TRIPLE" sectors.
- If the wheel stops on a Double or Triple, all multipliers on the wheel are doubled or tripled, and the wheel spins once again.
- The optimum possible win in this round is topped at an astonishing **20,000 x** the player's bet.

Strategy and Tips for Playing Crazy Time

While Crazy Time is basically a video game of possibility governed by a random number generator (RNG) and physical mechanics, players can use certain techniques to handle their bankroll efficiently:



- **Cover the Bonus Rounds:** Many players select to put little bets on all 4 bonus rounds on every spin. Since the perk video games are where the enormous payments live, this guarantees you never lose out when a

reward hits.

- **Balance Risk and Reward:** Betting specifically on the number "1" gives you the greatest analytical possibility of winning frequently, however the payments are low. Alternatively, wagering only on "Crazy Time" means enduring long droughts in hopes of striking the huge one. A well balanced approach works best for a lot of casual players.
- **Use Bankroll Management:** Decide on a spending plan before you start playing and stick to it. Game shows are busy, and it is simple to get caught up in the excitement of successive losses or near-misses.
- **Enjoy the Statistics:** While past spins do not determine future outcomes (the gambler's fallacy), looking at the current history ticker can help you determine the present rhythm of the video game.
