Is dermatofibroma a cyst?

Dermatofibroma is an usual benign mesenchymal skin tumor. Sweat air duct cyst is an unusual benign lesion consisting of squamous and glandular cells. We report an unusual situation of a dermatofibroma bordering a sweat duct cyst of the shin.
