- **Use two-factor authentication:** Protect your Steam account with Steam Guard to avoid unauthorized access to your inventory and market transactions.

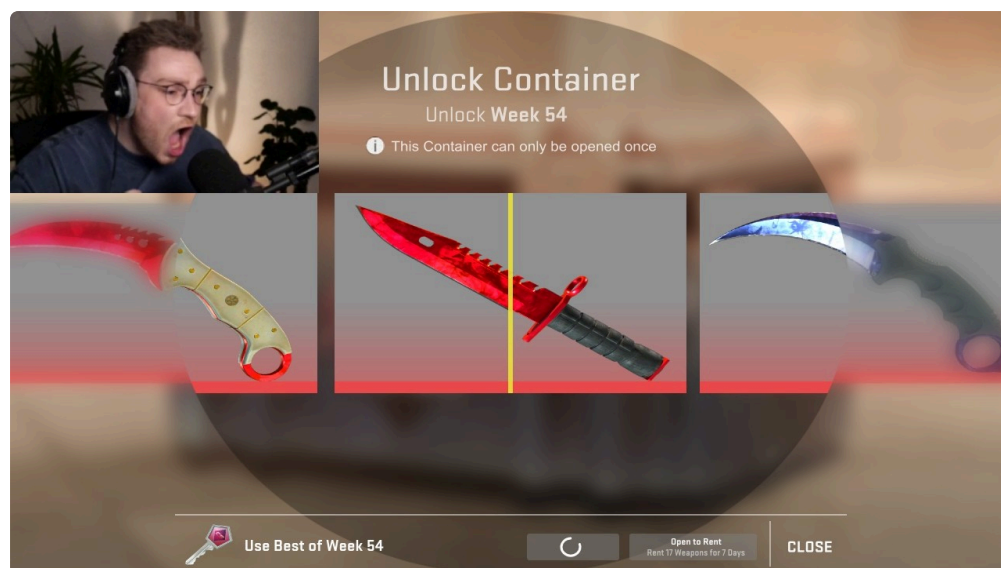
7. Regularly Asked Questions
