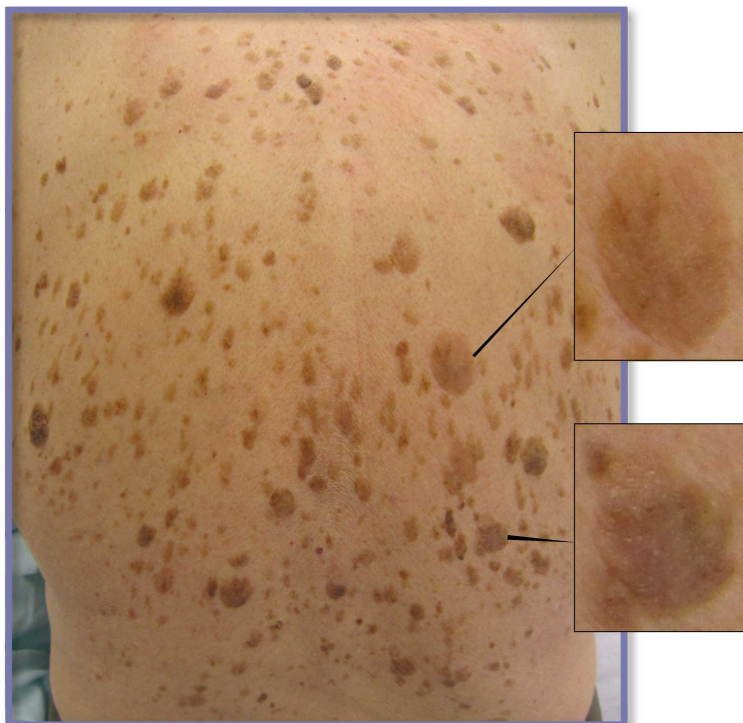
Exactly how do I understand if a skin sore is cancer?
