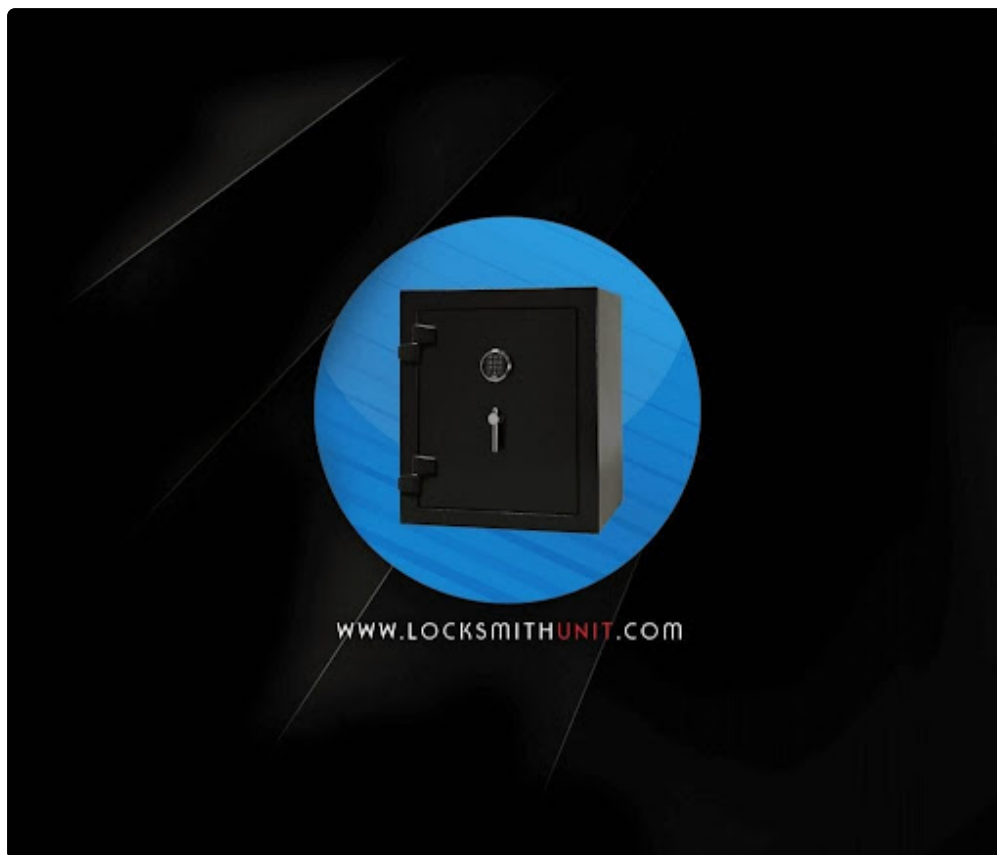


For homes, offices, storefronts, and back doors, lock work is rarely just about hardware, because the right fix depends on how the door is used and what kind of access it needs.
