- **Battle-Scarred (BS):** 0.45-- 1.00 (Heavy damage, rust, or missing out on paint)

It is essential to note that not all skins are offered in every wear condition. Some skins are capped and can not drop as Factory New, heavily affecting their rarity and subsequent market price.

The Steam Community Market and Player-Driven Economy

Not all gamers choose to open cases themselves. Instead, a prospering secondary market exists where players purchase and offer skins straight. The economy of CS: GO cases and skins is completely player-driven, dictated by supply and demand.

Factors Influencing Skin and Case Prices:
