In kitchens with customized kitchen cabinets, I prefer to run the cupboard crown cleanly into the room crown with a micro screen. If you are working with stock cabinetry, a small filler and faded rail can smooth the distance to the ceiling and dodge the airborne dirt and dust ledge that people today grumble about.

Wainscoting, wall panels, and the danger of overdoing it

One stack of books laid flat, one ceramic, a plant with texture, and space around every. A bench desires only a throw and one cushion.
