

Once the truck pulls away from your old address, a few final steps remain before the property is truly ready to hand off. **Movers in DMV** often see these post-load tasks overlooked in the rush of moving day, but a short cleanup checklist closes out the process properly.

Doing a Final Walkthrough

Walking through every room, closet, and storage area after the crew finishes loading confirms nothing was left behind. A DMV Moving Company typically encourages clients to do this walkthrough alongside the crew lead before the truck departs, catching any forgotten items while the movers are still on-site to load them.

Checking often-overlooked spots like attic spaces, under-stair storage, and garage shelving prevents the frustrating discovery of forgotten belongings after the moving truck has already left for the new address.

Basic Cleanup Before Leaving

Sweeping floors and wiping down empty shelves or cabinets leaves the space in reasonable condition for the next occupant or for a final property inspection, if one is required as part of a lease or sale agreement. DMV Movers do not typically include deep cleaning as part of their service, so scheduling a separate cleaning service in advance covers this step if a more thorough cleaning is needed.

Support Through the Final Steps

Handling Keys and Utilities

Confirming the timeline for returning keys to a landlord or new homeowner, along with scheduling utility shutoffs at the old address, are administrative tasks that pair naturally with the final walkthrough. Handling these details on moving day, rather than days later, closes out the old address cleanly.

- Walk through every room and storage area before the truck departs
- Check attics, under-stair storage, and garage shelving for forgotten items
- Sweep floors and wipe down empty surfaces
- Confirm key handoff and utility shutoff timelines

Wrapping Up the Old Address Properly

These final steps take relatively little time compared to the rest of the move, but skipping them can lead to forgotten belongings or an unfinished handoff. A DMV Moving Company that builds this walkthrough into its standard process helps clients close out the old address with confidence.
