- Extras and add-ons. Video camera inspections, jetting a blocked outlet, baffle replacement, or locator work to find an unmarked tank add to the billing. Some deserve it, others are not required each time. More on that below.

You control numerous of these aspects. Mark the cover locations, trim shrubs, and move vehicles or heavy planters. Do not assume all tanks equal. More recent plastic tanks can crack if a heavy truck parks above them. Old concrete tanks in some cases have thin lids that can not be stood on.
