On heavy profiles with lower back beveled edges, we undercut by means of a hair to keep caulk traces invisible. Between coats, a quick pass with a quality grit sanding sponge removes grime nibs and stands the fibers down, quite on waterborne approaches that bring up grain reasonably.

Fascia adjoining to roofing collects granules and healthy particles. Before portray, we easy that line thoroughly and verify for nail pops from thermal action. A little consciousness like that prevents the fresh coat from cracking along that higher part. For deck skirts and uncovered stair stringers, I generally specify a decrease sheen end that hides grime enhanced and use yet another coat on the minimize ends.

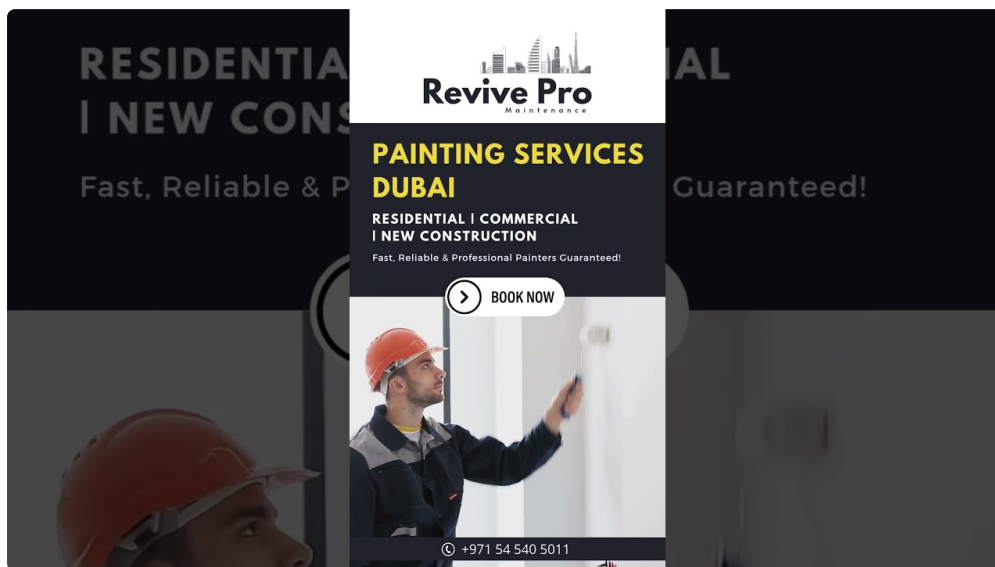
