- A lot of these websites need logging in through Steam, which can expose accounts to phishing frauds or API frauds.
- Platforms that ask users to deposit funds or products just to unlock a "free" case are typically predatory.
- Valve actively punish gambling and unapproved trading bots, suggesting users run the risk of having their Steam inventories trade-banned.

Stick strictly to official Valve drop systems and the official Steam Community Market to keep accounts totally protected.

1. Do I need CS: GO/CS2 Prime Status to get free cases?
