What is Crazy Time?

At its core, Crazy Time is a live dealer game developed around a massive, vertically mounted 54-segment wheel. Hosted by an bitz.io energetic, live presenter in a vibrant, Willy Wonka-esque studio, the game streams in real-time to players around the world.

Unlike standard table video games like blackjack or roulette, Crazy Time needs no complex memorization of guidelines or method charts. Gamers merely place bets on where they think the wheel will stop, making it available to absolute novices while still providing the high volatility and massive win potential that skilled gamblers long for.

How the Game is Played

Every video game round starts with a wagering stage. Players have a minimal time to put their chips on one or more of the 8 available wagering options on the virtual design. These choices include 4 numbers (1, 2, 5, and 10) and 4 unique bonus games.

When betting closes, the live host spins the huge wheel. At the same time, a different two-reel slot positioned above the main wheel-- called the **Top Slot**-- spins along with it.



The Top Slot Mechanism

Before the wheel stops, the Top Slot produces a random multiplier and appoints it to one of the 8 betting options on the wheel.

- If the Top Slot multiplier and the wheel outcome align on the exact same section, the multiplier applies to that win.
- If the outcome is a perk game, the multiplier enhances all the multipliers *inside* that particular reward round, resulting in possibly astronomical payouts.

Comprehending the Wheel Segments and Payouts

The 54 sectors on the Crazy Time wheel are distributed amongst numbers and perk video games. Naturally, the lower-paying numbers appear much more regularly on the wheel than the uncommon perk rounds.

Breakdown of Wheel Segments

- **Number 1:** Appears 21 times (Payout: 1:1)
- **Number 2:** Appears 13 times (Payout: 2:1)
- **Number 5:** Appears 7 times (Payout: 5:1)
- **Number 10:** Appears 4 times (Payout: 10:1)
- **Coin Flip Bonus:** Appears 4 times
- **Cash Hunt Bonus:** Appears 2 times
- **Pachinko Bonus:** Appears 2 times
- **Crazy Time Bonus:** Appears 1 time

Dive Into the Four Crazy Time Bonus Rounds

The true magic-- and the source of the video game's most significant payouts-- lies within its 4 interactive bonus rounds. Whenever the wheel arrive at a benefit segment, players who put a bet on that particular function are transported to a secondary game screen.

1. Coin Flip

The easiest of the 4 bonuses, this round includes a coin with a red side and a blue side.

- Each side is appointed a random multiplier before the flip.
- The host presses a button to flip the coin, and whichever color lands face-up awards the corresponding multiplier to the player's bet.

2. Money Hunt

This is a huge interactive shooting gallery featuring a screen with 108 random multipliers concealed behind different symbols (like a cactus, target, or chef's hat).

- Players use a virtual crosshair to intend and contend a symbol of their option before a countdown timer expires.
- Once time goes out, all signs reveal their covert multipliers, and the gamer wins whatever value they shot.

3. Pachinko

Motivated by the standard Japanese arcade game, Pachinko features a large wall filled with physical pegs.

- The host drops a puck from the top of the board.

- The puck bounces randomly down the pegs until it lands in among the slots at the bottom, which includes a multiplier.
- If the puck lands in a **"DOUBLE"** slot, all multipliers on the board double, and the puck is dropped once again for an even larger payment.

4. Crazy Time

The crown gem of the game. When set off, the host opens a red door leading into a surreal, brightly colored virtual world featuring an enormous, 64-segment mega-wheel.

- Gamers must choose one of 3 flappers: **Green, Blue, or Yellow**.
- The host spins the wheel, and the flapper the gamer selected determines their prize.
- This wheel features **"DOUBLE"** and **"TRIPLE"** sections. If the flapper indicate one of these, all multipliers on the wheel increase, and the wheel spins once again-- enabling wins to scale as much as the game's maximum cap of 500,000 x!

Techniques for Playing Crazy Time

While Crazy Time is eventually a video game of opportunity determined by RNG and physics, gamers frequently utilize different betting strategies to manage their bankroll and optimize their time playing.

Popular Betting Approaches

- **The Safe/Conservative Strategy:** Betting heavily on the numbers (1 and 2) together with a small cover bet on the bonus rounds. This technique yields regular, smaller sized wins, keeping the bankroll steady for longer durations.
- **The Bonus-Only Strategy:** Ignoring the numbers totally and positioning small bets specifically on the four bonus rounds (Coin Flip, Cash Hunt, Pachinko, and Crazy Time). This method is high-risk, high-reward, as it depends on striking the relatively rare benefit segments to see a return.
- **The Spread Strategy:** Placing bets throughout a variety of sectors (numbers and rewards alike) to guarantee that a high percentage of the wheel yields some type of return.

Essential Tips for Beginners

- **Set a Budget:** Decide on a fixed home entertainment spending plan before visiting and never chase losses.
- **Understand Volatility:** Bonus rounds do not hit on every spin. Expect droughts while waiting for a reward to set off.
- **Play for Entertainment:** Remember that live casino video games are created mainly for enjoyable and entertainment, not as a reputable source of earnings.
