

Garage door repair Solutions for Los Angeles Households

Common Overhead Garage Door Problems

When a Garage Door Will Not Open or Close

A dead remote battery, tripped circuit breaker, disconnected opener, or locked door can prevent operation. If the garage door won't close, inspect the area around the photo eye sensors for dirt, objects, or misalignment.

Photo eye sensors sit near the floor on both sides of the opening. They must face each other and have an unobstructed path. Proper garage door sensor alignment can correct some closing problems, but blinking lights or repeated reversal may indicate damaged wiring or a faulty sensor.

The garage door motor may run while the door remains stationary if the drive gear, trolley, or connection arm is damaged. Grinding, clicking, or sudden stopping can also point to an opener problem. Do not repeatedly operate an opener that is pulling against a jammed door. Disconnecting the opener and manually testing the door requires caution because a spring or cable failure can cause the door to fall.

Indicators You Need Garage Door Spring Replacement

Typical indications of spring failure include a door that feels abnormally heavy, rises only a few inches, closes too quickly, or remains crooked in the opening. You may see a visible gap in a coil, hear a loud snap, or notice that the garage door cable has become loose. These symptoms usually require expert inspection rather than ongoing use.

A torsion spring is mounted above the door and uses balanced tension to balance its weight. An extension spring is installed along the horizontal tracks and stretches as the door moves. Both systems can be dangerous when handled without specialized equipment. Torsion spring replacement and extension spring replacement should be performed by a skilled professional who can verify balance, cable placement, and safety hardware.

What Affects the Cost of Garage Door Repair?

Several factors affect garage door repair cost:

- **Repair labor:** Limited access, difficult adjustments, and extra testing can increase labor time.
- **Replacement parts:** Springs, cables, rollers, brackets, panels, and openers differ in quality and cost.
- **Emergency garage door repair:** Evening, weekend, and holiday appointments may carry after-hours charges.
- **Garage door size:** A large or heavy door requires stronger springs, cables, and opener components than a small single-car door.

Garage door safety and maintenance tips

Hinges, rollers, bearings, and springs may require appropriate garage door lubricant, while tracks typically should remain clean rather than heavily greased. Clean off dirt and inspect for loose bolts, frayed cables, cracked rollers, and rust.

Preventive maintenance can extend component life and expose problems before they become emergencies. Keep the area around the door clear, avoid hanging objects from tracks, and do not paint over moving hardware. If the door is unbalanced or a spring appears damaged, discontinue use and request professional service. Routine garage door maintenance is a safer choice and usually less disruptive than responding to a complete failure.
