Low Float Exclusivity-- Factory New(0.000.07)surfaces are far less common than Battle-Scared(0.45 1.00). Special Finishes-- Doppler, Fade, and

Doppler-Phase finishes often feature rarer color scheme, raising their market price.

Supply Shock-- Sudden restrictions or eliminations
