The Five Exterior Wear Conditions

The condition of a skin significantly impacts its visual appeal and market value. Valve categorizes drifts into 5 distinct tiers:

Wear Condition Float Range Description **Factory New (FN)** 0.00-- 0.07 Pristine condition with little to no noticeable wear. Frequently the most expensive tier. **Minimal Wear (MW)** 0.07-- 0.15 Small signs of wear, typically visible only on close inspection or particular high-friction areas. **Field-Tested (FT)** 0.15-- 0.38 Noticeable scratches and endure the body and paintwork. The most typical market tier. **Well-Worn (WW)** 0.38-- 0.45 Significant wear, fading colors, and popular scratches. **Battle-Scarred (BS)** 0.45-- 1.00 Greatly distressed, rusted, or scraped. Some skins look completely different (and distinctively gritty) in this condition.

Loadouts in CS2 are classified by weapon types, **CSGO glove skins** with gamers typically selecting a main rifle (AK-47 for Terrorists, M4A4 or M4A1-S for Counter-Terrorists), a sniper rifle (AWP), and sidearms.

The CS2 Economy: More Than Just Pixels

2. **Trade-Up Contracts:** Players can trade 10 skins of a specific tier for one skin of the next higher tier, burning supply in the procedure and modifying market dynamics.
