Why Buy Cheap Cases?

2. Long-Term Speculation and Collecting

Many players buy cheap cases wholesale-- often hundreds at a time-- and save them in their Steam stock. When cases shift out of the active drop pool, their rates naturally value.



Tips for Smart Case Buying and Opening

To make the most of value and avoid typical pitfalls, gamers should follow a couple of reliable finest practices.

- **Set a Strict Budget:** Decide ahead of time just how much cash will be invested in cases and secrets every month. Treat it as home entertainment costs, not a financial investment method.
