- **2020-- 2021:** Temporary COVID-19 restrictions are introduced, capping deposit limitations and bonus deals.
- **2023-- Present:** Stricter enforcement versus unlicensed operators, increased concentrate on anti-money laundering (AML), and tighter controls on video game software service providers.

The Regulatory Framework: Spelinspektionen and Compliance

- **Spelpaus:** A centralized national self-exclusion register permitting gamers to ban themselves from all certified gambling sites and land-based venues with a single click.

- **Perks:** Licensed operators are strictly limited to offering a single welcome benefit per player per license.
