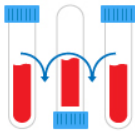
- Or if you're just passing by as we were, it's dead simple to see them by car.

Do not miss out on the salt crafts and museum workshop, where you can admire a distinct screen of gently handcrafted 'salt boats'. ' El Museo del Mar y la Sal' sea and salt museum reflects the history of Torrevieja's seafaring and salt removal traditions. There are a number of walkways and outing locations, and a cycle course along the Via Verde which adheres to the old railway line in between the salt lakes, along the coasts of the pink shallows, down to the coastline by Acequión beach.

Torrevieja is primarily a resort town for package vacations and coastline relaxation. If you have actually ever before seen a child flamingo you'll recognize that they are not pink. You'll understand where they are as you'll be able to see trodden paths through the grass.



What's wonderful regarding this spot is that there's also a mud pool nearby. Officially, swimming in the Salinas de Torrevieja is not allowed, as it's a safeguarded all-natural area. The pink color, triggered by the high degrees of salt bicarbonate and potassium chloride, isn't constantly simple to see. You can take a dip in the salt lakes, ride a captivating little train, and enjoy scenic walks. With each other, these factors make the salt lakes of Torrevieja a prominent destination for many vacationers, commonly as an excursion from Alicante or from the Spanish area of Murcia.
