Etiquette is the distinction among "I'm staring at you" and "we're sharing this." It is also the distinction between a amateur who makes error gracefully and one who steamrolls the vibe.

Treat the target market like collaborators, not like pursuits.

- Smile, then converse at a widely used volume so other folks experience welcome, now not ordered around.

- If you want silence, request it kindly and in short, not like you might be scolding a room.
