Understanding the Wheel Segments

The 52-segment wheel is divided into numbers and benefit video games. The numbers pay even cash or much better, while the reward symbols provide players entry into the game's heading acts.

Here is how the wheel is distributed:

- **Number 1:** 21 sections (Pays 1:1)
- **Number 2:** 13 sectors (Pays 2:1)
- **Number 5:** 7 sectors (Pays 5:1)
- **Number 10:** 4 sectors (Pays 10:1)
- **Coin Flip:** 4 sectors
- **Pachinko:** 2 sections

- **Money Hunt:** 2 sections
- **Crazy Time:** 1 section

The Top Slot Feature

Before every spin of the main wheel, a two-reel mini slots located straight above the wheel spins all at once. [crazy time](#)

- **Reel 1** screens a bet spot (either a number or a reward video game).
- **Reel 2** screens a multiplier (varying from 2x as much as 50x).

If the bet spot and the multiplier align horizontally, that multiplier is applied to the corresponding section on the main wheel for that round. If the wheel lands on that segment, all wins for that bet are increased accordingly, setting the phase for massive payouts.

Dive Into the Four Bonus Rounds

The true magic-- and volatility-- of Crazy Time lies in its 4 interactive bonus offer rounds. These games transport gamers out of the studio by means of CGI and offer the game's greatest win capacity.

1. Coin Flip

The most basic of the bonus offer rounds, Coin Flip features a red-and-blue token turned by a maker.

- **How it works:** Before the flip, both sides of the coin are assigned random multipliers.
- **The Outcome:** Whichever color lands deal with up awards the player the multiplier connected to that side.

2. Pachinko

Motivated by the conventional Japanese arcade video game, Pachinko features a big physical wall filled with pegs.

- **How it works:** The host drops a puck from the top of the board. It bounces randomly down through the pegs till it lands in among a number of multiplier slots at the bottom.
- **The "Double" Feature:** If the puck lands in a "DOUBLE" slot, all multipliers at the bottom of the board double, and the puck is dropped again for a possibility at even larger rewards.

3. Cash Hunt

Money Hunt is an interactive shooting gallery game presented on an enormous screen with 108 random multipliers concealed behind various signs (like [crazy time demo casino](#) a cactus, a target, or a chef's hat).

- **How it works:** Players utilize an on-screen cannon to aim and contend a symbol of their choice before the countdown timer ends. Once the timer ends, all players reveal the multiplier concealed behind their selected target. (Note: In automated play, the game picks a target for the gamer).

4. Crazy Time

The ultimate benefit round and the hardest to activate. The host opens a red door, leading gamers into a surreal, brightly colored virtual world including an enormous, 64-segment wheel.

- **How it works:** Players must choose among 3 flappers (Green, Blue, or Yellow). The host spins the wheel, and whichever multiplier the selected flapper indicate when the wheel stops is awarded to the gamer.
- **The "Double" and "Triple" segments:** Just like Pachinko, if the wheel stops on a "DOUBLE" or "TRIPLE" segment, all multipliers on the wheel boost appropriately, and the wheel is spun again. This is where the optimum 20,000 x multiplier can be achieved.

Advantages and disadvantages of Playing Crazy Time

Like all casino games, Crazy Time includes its own distinct set of benefits and possible disadvantages.

Pros:

- **Unmatched Entertainment Value:** High-energy hosts, bright visuals, and game-show styling make it incredibly enjoyable to enjoy and play.

- **Busy:** Rounds happen quickly, which can lead to overspending if gamers do not handle their bankrolls carefully.

Fundamental Strategies for Crazy Time

While Crazy Time is a game of pure chance determined by a random number generator (RNG) and physical wheel physics, gamers often employ betting strategies to manage threat and extend their playtime.

- **The Cover-All Strategy:** Betting on all or the majority of the segments (numbers and bonus offer games) guarantees you hardly ever miss out on a spin, though the cost of covering the board can outweigh the smaller sized payouts.
- **Bonus Chasing:** Focusing solely on the bonus offer rounds (Coin Flip, Pachinko, Cash Hunt, and Crazy Time). This is a high-risk, high-reward method considering that reward rounds occur on just 9 of the 52 segments.
- **Statistical Betting:** Relying on the game's history tracker. Some players like to bank on sections that haven't hit in a long time (the "hot/cold" fallacy), though past spins statistically have no bearing on future outcomes.
