Patterns and Personalization

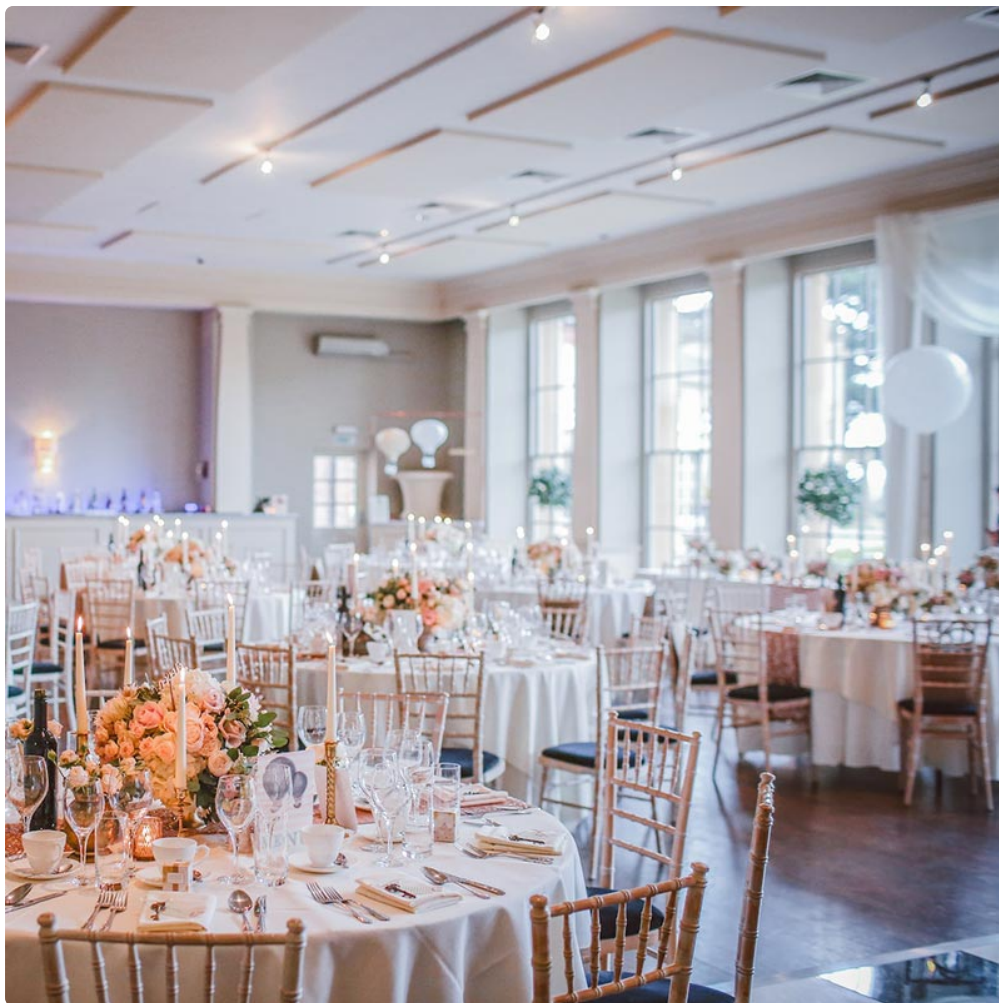
