What drivers usually need first

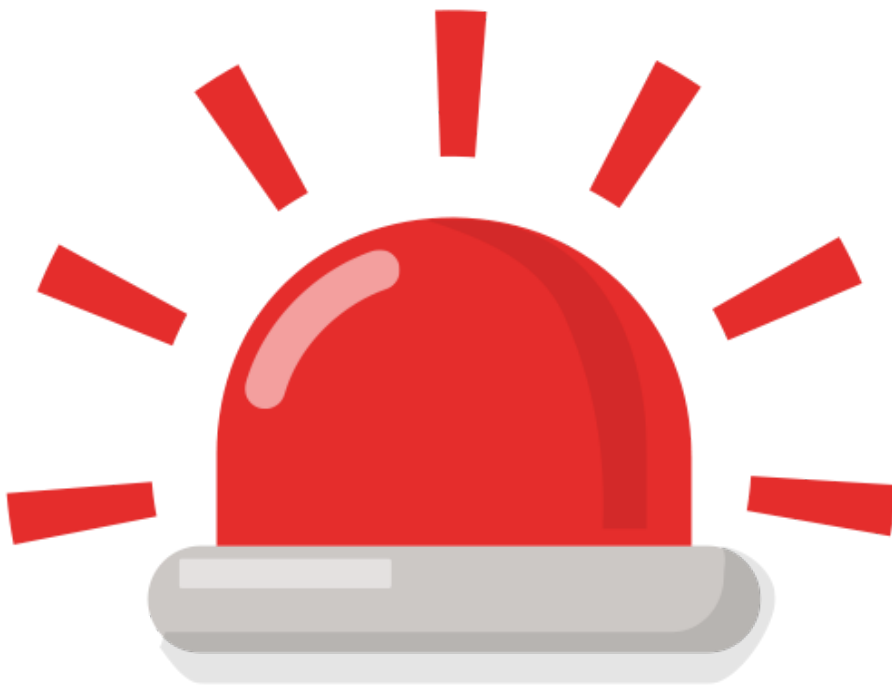
