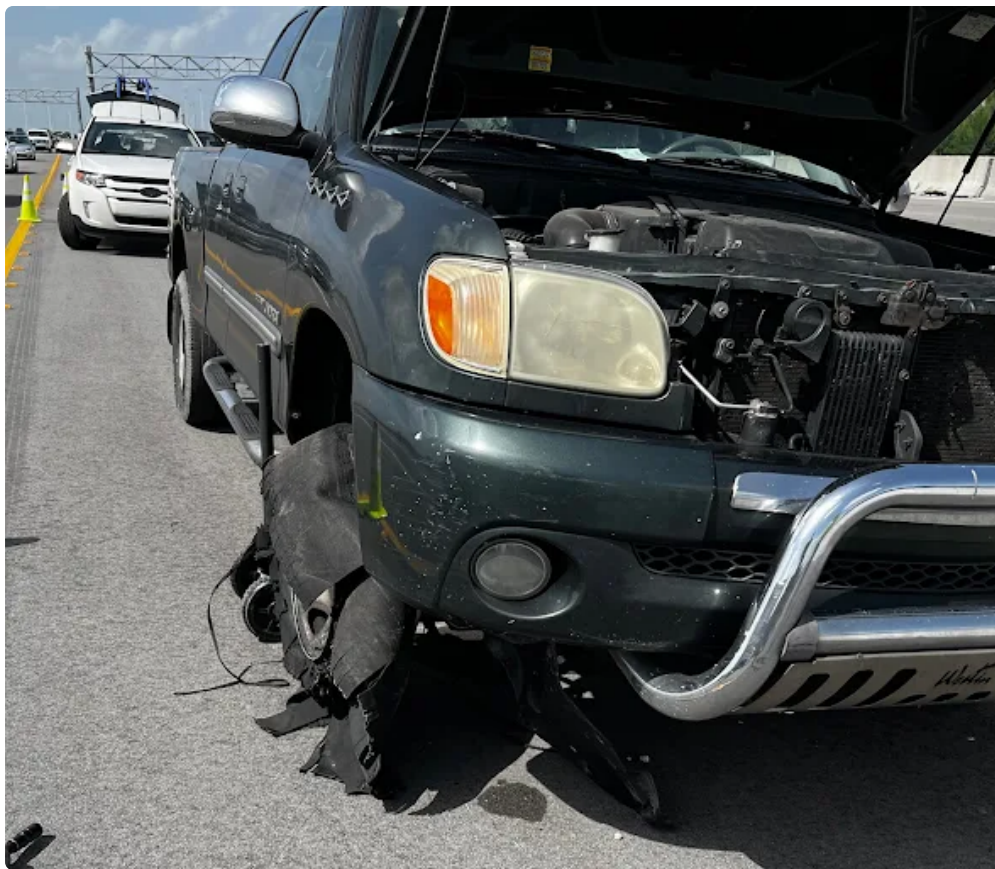

We deployed inflatable air wedges and a low-profile jack with rubber pucks to raise just sufficient to loose the nostril.
