* Note: "Surr" stands for Late Surrender (if offered). "S/D" stands for Double if permitted, otherwise Stand.

Key Rules to Look for in Live Casinos

- **Dealer Soft 17 Rule:** Check whether the dealer should strike or base on a soft 17 (an Ace and a 6). A dealership standing on soft 17 is more beneficial to the player.
