Are the springs visibly damaged or excessively worn? Is there a gap in the weather seal at the bottom? Is one panel under more stress than the others? The answers point toward the right repair.

Some issues can wait a few days. Others should not. If a spring has broken, stop using the door until it is repaired. If a panel is bent enough to create binding, continued use can damage rollers, hinges, and the opener. If the door is noisy but still functional, that may be the right moment to schedule service before the problem escalates. Good maintenance rarely feels urgent until the moment it suddenly is.
