Large views over the Windrush Valley unfold as the trail swells towards the expressive remains of Widford, a deserted middle ages village. Complying with the river's left bank, the course carefully overviews you toward Burford, with its honey-colored stone buildings, eccentric antique shops, charming church, and numerous excellent delis. The cairn on the Corn Du summit is a Bronze Age burial chamber (more on that particular below). A brief, high final section with stone steps brings you onto the level sandstone plateau. Turn right at the saddle and adhere to the path to the summit.



Along the road, you'll additionally find two outstanding wild swimming areas. This easy-going walk starts in the historical town of Minster Lovell, where the Old Swan pub keeps an eye out over the River Windrush as it curves with dignity around the village cricket pitch.
