Getting these products can be done through numerous channels:

- **In-Game Drops**-- Participate in the initial operation or event where the case was offered. Some cases still drop sometimes throughout "replay" objectives, though the probability remains small.
- **Marketplaces**-- Platforms such as the Steam Community Market, Buff.163, or third-party skin websites (e.g., CSGOStash) list uncommon cases. Always verify the seller's track record and usage escrow services.
