The owner waited a week previously loading shelves. Total time, eight running days with a 4 user workforce, just over 400 linear toes of trim, 17 doors, and 34 cabinet pieces. Three months later, we did a courtesy verify. No blockading, no sags, and the stairwell looked flat at sundown.
