Color transparency catches many homeowners off guard. We sanded profiles with foam pads and shot two topcoats of satin urethane. Doors had been sprayed flat in the store with the comparable gadget. Hardware holes had been stuffed and re-drilled to modify from 3-inch pulls to 5-inch, which required a jig and staying power to preserve strains immediately.

From arrival to final wipe-down took 8 running days. At day three after rehang, the end felt dry but we still told mild use for about a weeks. Six months later the client called, no longer with a criticism, yet to agenda ceiling painting features inside the adjacent kin room due to the fact that the cabinets made the outdated ceiling seem worn-out. That is the ripple impression a nicely-finished cabinet end has on a abode.
