Note: Total sectors equal 52. The bonus rounds collectively inhabit 9 sectors, indicating a gamer will see a bonus offer function roughly every 5.7 spins on average.

Exploring the Four Bonus Rounds in Demo Mode

The main attraction of Crazy Time is its quartet of extremely imaginative benefit minigames. Using a [crazy time demo casino](#) demonstration or spectator mode allows users to witness these features without monetary stress.

- **1. Coin Flip:** A simple red-vs-blue digital coin toss. Before the flip, multipliers are designated to each side. Whichever side lands face up awards the corresponding multiplier to the player's stake.
- **2. Money Hunt:** A giant screen featuring 108 random multipliers concealed behind shooting gallery symbols. Players (or the game AI in demo/auto-play) aim a cannon at a target, exposing the multiplier below.

- **Treat it as Entertainment:** The primary objective of Crazy Time is entertainment. The potential for high multipliers (as much as 20,000 x in the Crazy Time bonus offer) is thrilling, however the home edge means the gambling establishment keeps a mathematical advantage over the long term.
