A condominium accessory unit: Durability and value management drove the determination. We laid a plain 12 by using 24 commercial-grade porcelain with epoxy grout and a steel facet profile. The tenant moved in with cast iron. After a year, the counter appears nearly new. Repairs have been 0, and cleaning is discreet. The metallic facet took a few scuffs, however they learn as commonly used wear.
