The surfaces which are toughest to reach in most cases get the least love, which is why fascia, barge boards, and window heads on higher memories fail first on DIY jobs.

We checked moisture at questionable trim - readings hovered at 12 to 14 percent after a dry spell - then primed with a tannin-blocking off acrylic on sanded cedar. We back-brushed two coats of a satin acrylic at the body and used a reasonably scale down sheen at the crown details to save glare down beneath the afternoon sunlight.

The property owner informed me later that the only funds spent turned into not the paint model however the time budgeted for caulking and notice-priming at elevation. Four years on, a brief visit for typhoon contact-americaconfirmed tight joints and consistent sheen, precisely what you prefer to work out on a tall outside.
