What is a Crazy Time Slot?

At its core, **Crazy Time** is a live dealer video game show constructed on the immense success of Evolution's earlier title, *Dream Catcher*. Hosted by an energetic live speaker in a vibrant, Willy Wonka-esque studio, the [crazy time game](#) video game centers around an enormous, vertically mounted wheel including 54 segments.

Gamers put bets on numbers (1, 2, 5, or 10) or on one of the 4 distinct bonus offer rounds. If the wheel stops on the sector a player has actually bet on, they win a payout or gain entry into an immersive mini-game.

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Understanding the Betting Layout

Before the wheel spins, gamers have a limited window to put their chips on the wagering grid. The grid consists of 8 unique wagering choices, split evenly between standard numbers and benefit triggers.

- **Number 1:** Appears 21 times on the wheel. Payment: 1:1.
- **Number 2:** Appears 13 times on the wheel. Payout: 2:1.
- **Number 5:** Appears 7 times on the wheel. Payout: 5:1.
- **Number 10:** Appears 4 times on the wheel. Payout: 10:1.
- **Coin Flip:** Appears 4 times on the wheel. Activates the Coin Flip perk.
- **Money Hunt:** Appears 2 times on the wheel. Triggers the Cash Hunt bonus offer.

- **Pachinko:** Appears 2 times on the wheel. Activates the Pachinko benefit.
- **Crazy Time:** Appears 1 time on the wheel. Triggers the ultimate reward round.

The Top Slot Feature: Amplifying the Action

Adding a layer of conventional slot mechanics to the video game, every spin of <https://bitz.io/games/crazy-time> the primary wheel is accompanied by a **Top Slot** located straight above the speaker and the wheel.

The Top Slot features 2 reels that spin concurrently:

1. **Reel 1:** Displays a wagering area (a number or a reward round).
2. **Reel 2:** Displays a multiplier value (varying from 2x as much as 50x).

If the horizontal line in the Top Slot links a betting area with a multiplier, that multiplier is applied to the outcome of the main wheel spin, supplied the wheel arrive on that particular area. If a bonus round is increased, all rewards inside that perk round are increased accordingly, resulting in the game's legendary huge payouts.

Deep Dive: The Four Bonus Rounds

The primary attraction of the Crazy Time slot experience depends on its 4 unique bonus offer video games. These mini-games transportation players far from the main wheel and into augmented-reality environments.

1. Coin Flip

- **Frequency:** 4 sectors on the wheel.
- **Mechanic:** A basic red and blue coin is turned by a mechanical flipper.
- **Payment:** Before the flip, random multipliers are assigned to both the red and blue sides of the coin. Whichever side lands face up determines the gamer's multiplier win.

2. Money Hunt

- **Frequency:** 2 sectors on the wheel.
- **Mechanic:** A massive screen displays 108 random multipliers concealed behind shooting gallery targets (symbols like a cactus, target, hat, etc).
- **Payout:** Players utilize an on-screen cannon to intend and contend a target of their option before time runs out, revealing the hidden multiplier beneath.

3. Pachinko

- **Frequency:** 2 sections on the wheel.
- **Mechanic:** Inspired by the conventional Japanese arcade video game, a glowing puck is dropped from the top of a massive wall filled with pegs.
- **Payout:** The puck bounces down the board up until it lands in a multiplier slot at the bottom. If it strikes a "DOUBLE" slot, all multipliers on the board double, and the puck is dropped once again.

4. Crazy Time

- **Frequency:** 1 sector on the wheel.
- **Mechanic:** Players travel through a red door into a virtual, psychedelic world including a massive giant wheel.

- **Payment:** Players select among 3 flippers (green, blue, or yellow). The presenter presses a huge red button to spin the huge wheel. It can yield multipliers as much as 20,000 x if "DOUBLE" or "TRIPLE" sectors are struck along the method.

Strategies for Playing the Crazy Time Slot

While Crazy Time is essentially a game of opportunity governed by a random number generator (RNG) and physical wheel physics, players often utilize various bankroll management techniques.

Typical Approaches Include:

- **The Conservative Approach (Number Betting):** Focusing primarily on numbers 1 and 2. Due to the fact that these appear frequently on the wheel, this technique intends to sustain a gamer's bankroll for longer periods, with occasional little wins.
- **The Bonus Hunter Strategy:** Wagering solely or greatly on the 4 benefit rounds (Coin Flip, Cash Hunt, Pachinko, Crazy Time). This technique accepts a higher threat of frequent losses in exchange for the possibility to enter the high-paying reward mini-games.
- **The Balanced Spread:** Spacing bets throughout both numbers and bonus offer rounds to make sure that frequent small wins from numbers can help fund the pursuit of benefit functions.

Tips for a Responsible and Enjoyable Experience

Because the pacing of a live game show is quick and the atmosphere is electric, it is easy to get captured up in the enjoyment. Keep these best practices in mind:

- **Set a Budget:** Decide beforehand just how much money you want to spend and stick strictly to that limitation.
- **Understand the RTP:** Keep in mind that benefit bets usually have a somewhat lower analytical Return to Player percentage than wagering on the number 1, balancing their potential for huge payments.
- **Treat it as Entertainment:** View the house edge and wagers as the expense of admission for an interactive home entertainment program instead of a dependable source of earnings.
- **Take Breaks:** Step away from the screen regularly to keep a clear head.
