3. Prime Status Benefits

4. Significant Tournaments and View Passes

During Valve-sponsored CS2 Major champions, viewers can purchase or often make Souvenir Packages.

- By seeing the tournament live via the Steam TV or in-game customer, or by taking part in the Pick 'Em Challenge utilizing a Viewer Pass, players can earn Souvenir Cases specific to that tournament.
- These cases do not require a key to open, making them 100% totally free worth as soon as obtained.
