Hardware holes had been filled and re-drilled to modify from three-inch pulls to 5-inch, which required a jig and staying power to save lines instantly.

From arrival to final wipe-down took eight operating days. At day 3 after rehang, the conclude felt dry yet we nevertheless instructed comfortable use for a couple of weeks.
