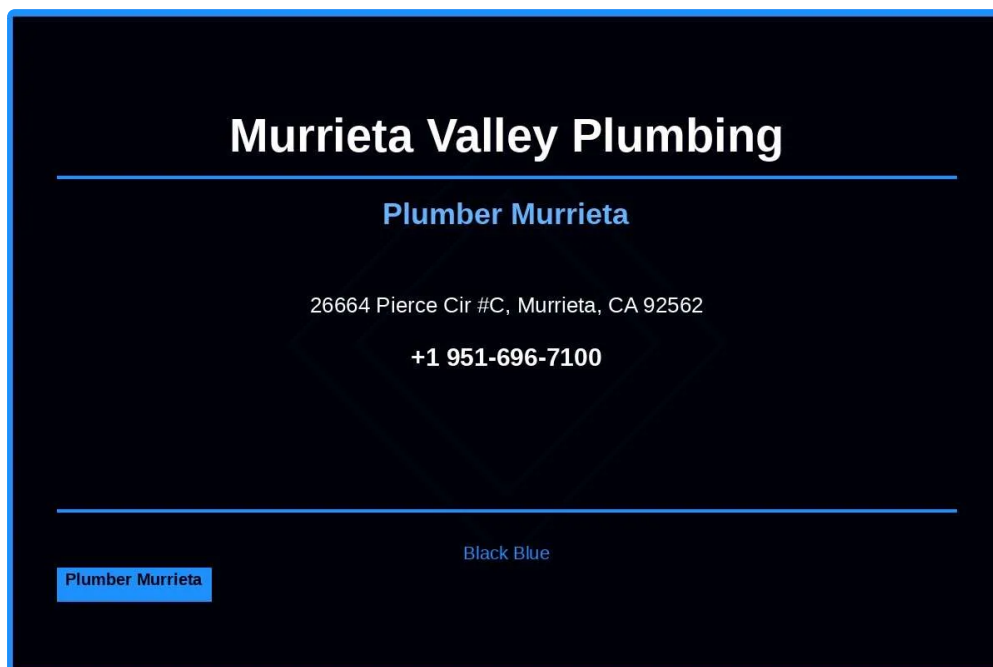

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One detail that gets overlooked in bathroom projects is ventilation and drainage slope, both of which affect how well a new shower or tub actually performs once tile goes down. A drain set at the wrong pitch will pool water no matter how good the fixtures above it are, and correcting that after tile is installed is far more expensive than getting it right during rough in.
