- Active Duty drop swimming pool cases drop frequently, while "Rare Drop Pool" cases have a microscopic chance of dropping (roughly 1% or lower).

### CS2 Case Odds and Probabilities

Valve is legally required in certain areas to publish the specific chances of unpacking items of varying rarities. While the precise tier of the weapon skin within a color category is consistent, the rarity tiers dictate the standard possibilities.

**Limited (Purple)** ~ 15.98% Uncommon skins with obvious style changes **Classified (Pink)** ~ 3.20% Rare,  
extremely in-depth skins **Covert (Red)** ~ 0.64% Premium flagship skins for the case **Exceedingly Rare (Gold)** ~  
0.26% Knives or Special Gloves

*Keep in mind: There is a different, independent 10% chance that any opened item will remain in **StatTrak** condition, which tracks the variety of kills made with that weapon.*

## Types of CS2 Cases

The CS2 case ecosystem is broadly divided into 2 main categories:

### 1. Active Drop Pool Cases

These are cases currently dropping to gamers actively using Valve official matchmaking servers. Because of the high supply, their market rates are typically low (typically under £ 1.00 GBP).

- *Examples:* Kilowatt Case, Gallery Case, Recoil Case.

### 2. Unusual (Discontinued) Drop Pool Cases

When Valve presents a new case, older cases are usually pressed into the "unusual drop pool." They rarely drop after matches, meaning their supply is strictly finite. As players open them, less exist, driving up the cost.

- *Examples:* Huntsman Weapon Case, CS: GO Weapon Case 3, Operation Breakout Weapon Case.
