* Note: "Surr" stands for Late Surrender (if readily available). "S/D" stands for Double if enabled, otherwise Stand.

Key Rules to Look for in Live Casinos

Not all live blackjack tables are developed equivalent. Before signing up with a virtual seat, gamers must thoroughly examine the specific guidelines of the table, as they straight impact your house edge.

- **Blackjack Payouts:** Always search for tables that pay **3:2** for a natural blackjack. Prevent tables that pay **6:5**, as this substantially increases your house benefit.
- **Dealership Soft 17 Rule:** Check whether the dealership should hit or stand on a soft 17 (an Ace and a 6). A dealer standing on soft 17 is more favorable to the player.
- **Double Down Restrictions:** Some tables restrict doubling down to difficult totals of 10 and 11 only, while others enable doubling on any 2 cards. The latter is constantly much better for the gamer.
- **Dividing Rules:** Look for tables that permit players to divide sets up to three or four times (leading to multiple hands) and those that allow doubling down after splitting (DAS).
